



SOMETIMES GOD HAS TO USE STRONG TAPS TO GET OUR ATTENTION

God's whispers and nudges happen more than you think. Nearly 150 teachers from Moorhead Schools, lost their jobs due to a financial crisis at the beginning of the 1980s. In 1981, we were expecting our third child in April, but were facing a huge challenge with the loss of my teaching position after eight years. There were no teaching jobs available anywhere. I had worked for Scheels Hardware in Moorhead over that winter, and

found a hardware managerial job offer in Milbank, SD. I met with one of the owners, in Fargo, who had another store in Browns Valley, MN and wanted to expand. He invited us to Milbank and offered us the job the end of March. Our daughter was born April 12. We accept-

ed and moved to Milbank, the end of May 1981. Interest rates were near 20 per cent which put us at high risk for failure. Fortunately, we were very successful, but it took lots of hard work and long hours.

We became active in our church, and I started teaching Sunday School in 1983. One Monday in early October, I was having coffee with the minister. I told him how much I loved teaching Sunday School again, and how I missed teaching school. The very next day, I got a call from Moorhead Schools, asking me to come back to Moorhead to teach a sixth grade class. I had gotten a call in the summer offering me a position, but I was not interested. Things were going well with the store, and I was a leader in the community. However, after that meeting and discussion with the minister, I knew where I belonged. God was leading me back to teaching. Little did I know the major impact I would have in the classroom, school, and district, all because of a whisper from God, guiding me to return to teaching. Two weeks later I was back in the classroom.

Unfortunately, the teachers went on strike in February of 1984, just months after I had returned. Obviously, it was a difficult time for all. Our original Moorhead church became divided. This was the church I grew up in, and was an active member. When a few members told my mother that I wasn't a good Christian, our family left the church and came to Grace, because Luann's parents attended Grace. It was hard on my mother when we left. I tried to console her, but it was difficult to be with people who called themselves Christians, but rather put politics and personal agendas ahead of God's love.

We are thankful that God guided us to Grace. In fact, it was a woman from Grace, Alice Neilson, who wasn't on either side, but helped settle the strike. It will be 40 years here at Grace for our family next spring. Many changes have come and gone at Grace. This church has had its struggles over the years also, but I remember a senior

member of the church telling me that this was her church. God had planted her here, and she would continue to do God's work, and not let any strife affect her Christian home at Grace. Wow! That's Powerful!!!

God has unique ways of guiding us to make decisions, or put us into places that we will be needed at God's point -of-time. It might be a dream, sermon, music, scripture, or just being still. Be ready for His call. Accept it. Be open so that the Holy Spirit can guide you.
